

By observing this class in China I was able to see some similarities like how students stood up to answer questions out loud. I also noticed that the level of teaching was pretty similar if not at a lower level than the E.P.I.K. course taught in Korea. Despite the vocabulary being a little less basic than the E.P.I.K. class, the students were asked to define holiday right from the start, and they were able to come up with terms such as vacation, trip, and suitcase. It seems the class was very well managed and well-behaved. The biggest take away for me - aside from seeing another course with lots of repetition - was that the students were in absolute awe by the teacher's photos from her travels.
